



Hurlingham Club
Buenos Aires, Argentina
October 11 – 14, 2017

EVENT: The ANNIKA Invitational Latin America is co-hosted by the ANNIKA Foundation and Asociacion Argentina de Golf (AAG) and sponsored by The R&A. The event is designed to be the premier event for junior girls (ages 12-18) in Latin America. It will be hosted in Argentina until 2018, and rotated between other Latin American countries beginning in 2019.

The event will play host to 60 girls. Each of the 29 Latin American federations has received exemptions for the top two WAGR ranked girls from their country. In the case that a country did not have two WAGR ranked girls, applications with resumes have been accepted.

HOST CLUB: The Hurlingham Club is a recognized golf and polo club in Hurlingham, located 45 minutes outside Buenos Aires. It was founded in 1888 by the local anglo-argentine community. The town of Hurlingham grew up around the club, taking its name. The first nine holes were built in 1892 and 30 years later, in 1922, the final nine holes were completed.

The club covers 73 hectares and has an 18-hole golf course, five polo fields, stables for 300 horses, schools of polo, horse and pony riding, 18 tennis courts (including six grass courts), a cricket pitch, two swimming pools and an indoor complex with a gym, squash courts and dressing rooms. The clubhouse has elegant function rooms, restaurants, bars and hotel rooms.

The par 71 layout (5,834 yards for women) is a parkland style with narrow fairways, small greens and deep bunkers. The course has hosted the Argentine Open Championship, the Argentine Ladies Open and many other prestigious amateur championships.

HOUSING AND MEALS: All players will be housed in the dormies at Hurlingham Club and will share a room with other players. The lodging is included in the entry fee. Breakfast, lunch and dinner will be provided on a daily basis for the players at the clubhouse.

TOURNAMENT GUESTS: Parents and guests are allowed to attend the event, but all functions and meals at the golf course will be for players only. The ANNIKA Invitational Latin America is designed to be a "players experience" where players are watched after from the second they land in Buenos Aires to the second they take off back to their home country.

ACTIVITIES: Each evening, there will be activities planned for the players ranging from a tour of Buenos Aires and a thematic show.

ANNIKA SORENSTAM: Annika, widely considered to be the best female ever to play the game, is the winner of 89 worldwide professional events including 72 LPGA events and 10 major championships. She will be present throughout the week to host a dinner, a clinic and share her "Winning Approach" with the players.

ENTRY FEE: There is a \$150 USD entry fee for each player which includes four rounds of golf, four nights of lodging, ground transportation and all meals and activities throughout the week. The players should not have any expenses while on site. Players are responsible for their airfare to/from the event.

CLIMATE: The temperatures during October in Buenos Aires are generally warm, ranging from 16-21° C (60-70° F).

GOLF CLUB STORAGE: Golf club storage is located by the No. 1 tee, where clubs can safely be left overnight.
