TERMS OF THE COMPETITION - Annex to the AAG Permanent Conditions -

APPLICABLE RULES – COMMITTEE

Play will be governed by the **Rules of Golf effective January 1st, 2019** (R&A Rules Limited), **the Local Rules and Conditions of Competitions organized or administrated by the AAG, the present Terms that extend them and/or modify and the Local Rules that are implemented.**

The Committee reserves the right to modify any of these Conditions and/or Local Rules for reasons of necessity and opportunity, which will be duly made known to the competitors.

PARTICIPATING PLAYERS – Eligibility

Argentine amateur players with national handicap up to 4 inclusive, valid as of October 7, 2019 may participate in this competition. Likewise, **foreign amateur players** invited or presented by their national association.

FORMAT OF PLAY – Qualifying Cuts

The Championship will be played to **72 holes, Stroke Pay Individual.**

After the 2nd day of play, a Qualifying Cut will be established. Players who are within the first 60 positions, and ties in the 60th position will be enabled to play the third round.

Once the round on Friday 8th is finished, a **second cut** will be established, after which the first 38 players can participate in the last round, tee times of two players per group.

For the mentioned cuts for Saturday 9th, ties on the limit position will be automatically according to the following, until achieving the first difference that solves the tie:

- Best last 18 holes,
- Best last 9 holes,
- Best last 6, or the last 3, 2 or final hole until a tie is completed.

RETURNING OF SCORECARD

A player's scorecard is officially returned to the Committee when the player has completely left the scoring office/área.

TIES

In the event of a tie, to define the **first place**, a sudden-death play off, stroke play, will be played, in the holes established by the Committee until the winner is established.

Ties in the second place will be automatically according to the following order until a tie is completed:

- Best last 36 holes,
- Best last 18 holes,
- Best last 9 holes,
- Best last 6, or the last 3, 2 or final hole until a tie is completed.

WHEN THE COMPETITION HAS BEEN CLOSED

The competition is deemed to have been closed when the winner has been awarded his prize, or in the absence of a Prize Giving Ceremony, when the Championship Committee has approved all the scores.
